For the BCU Harvard style, list the first 10 authors and then use et al. after the tenth. For example: Haagsma, J. A., Olij, B. F., Majdan, M., van Beeck, E. F., Vos, T., Castle, C. D., Dingels, Z. V., Fox, J. T., Hamilton, E. B., Liu, Z. et al. (2020) Falls in older aged adults in 22 European countries: incidence, mortality and burden of disease from 1990 to 2017.

The BCU Harvard style for citing Hansard conforms to the House of Commons Information Office Factsheet G17. Hansard citations should not be included in your reference list as their citation contains the entire reference. The word "Hansard" should be provided in italics, then a comma, then the correct Hansard citation format.

The Harvard (author-date) system is comprised of two elements: an in-text citation and a bibliography at the end of the document. In the text of an assignment, ideas taken from other people are indicated by placing the author's surname and the date of publication in brackets. The bibliography at the end of the document then lists the references in alphabetical order by author's surname.
