The Rolex bracelet code can be found on the inside of the clasp hinge. There, you'll find a code which represents the year and month of which the watch was manufactured.

Rolex bracelet codes are found on the inner part of the Rolex bracelet clasp and started in the 1950's when Rolex also began stamping the inner caseback of their watches.

Each Rolex reference had it's own specific Rolex logo & reference number inside their case back, up till like 1966/67 we also see the date added once left the manufactory. As most Rolex are perpetual calibers, you can spot a worn out automatic rotor leaving marks in the case back.

Rolex serial numbers 2013; Rolex serial numbers location; FIND THE MODEL NUMBER ON YOUR ROLEX WATCH. The model or reference number is located on the side of the watch case at the 12 o'clock position. As with the serial number, the bracelet must be detached from the 12 o'clock side of the case to be able to check the serial number.

A Rolex reference number and Rolex serial number appear on the case of your Rolex. Depending on the year of manufacture, a reference number will be four to six digits. These digits define its features. Serial numbers can be found inbetween the lugs on the side of the case at the 6 o'clock side, behind the bracelet.
